As we were talking, my wife began talking about the need for salvation, and my wife called for me to speak with the person. The person is signed up for an experimental surgery and is scheduled to have the pancreas removed and placed on medicine for the remainder of life. The person was reluctant and thought it selfish to get saved based on fear of a dangerous surgery! I explained that from the heart trust and belief in Jesus Christ the Son of the living God is the most important factor in salvation and for about 20 – 30 minutes I showed the scripture on salvation and suddenly the person said, with tears, "I am going to get saved before we leave." Without any prompt, the person got down on their knees and we prayed together, and the person tearfully and joyfully received Christ as personal Savior! Praise God.

Our building ceiling needed a lot of work and requested prayer. After much prayer and consideration, I contacted a professional Inspector-Hawkey Inspection – a good name for the purpose! The inspection service conducted a very thorough inspection of the ceiling which revealed several hidden serious issues. The owner told us that he could not make the required repairs and he released the Church from the contract. God gave me peace about the situation, so we trusted God and moved everything out on the 24th of June, to a residence and met there for a while. After about a month of looking and praying, the Lord provided a very nice place on the main road through town.

We moved in August 1st and we had our first service there on the 4th.
